

..... How to Make a Birthday Banner

The Confetti Foundation

- ① Cut out each letter
(follow shape outline)



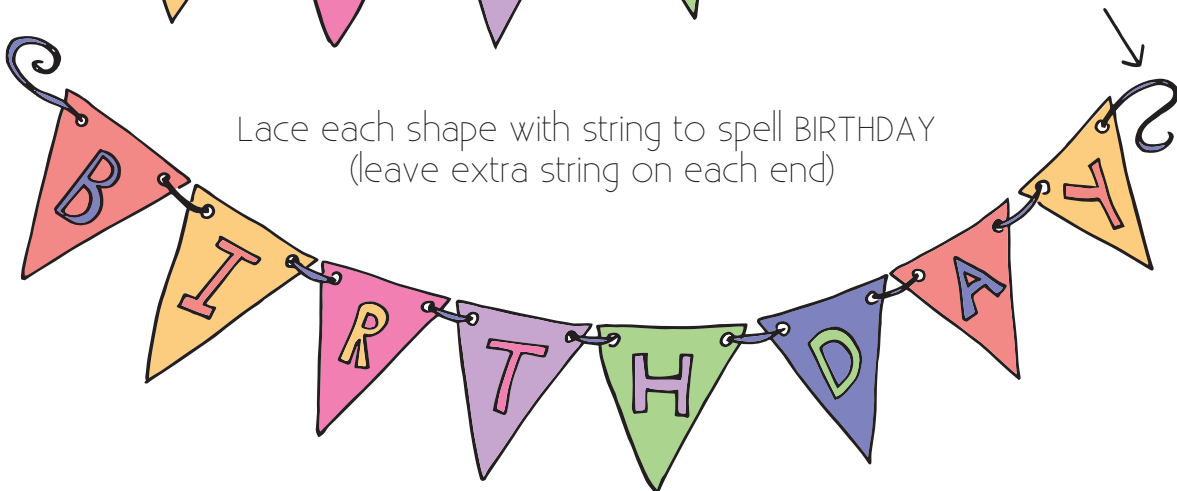
- ② Punch Holes at top
of each shape



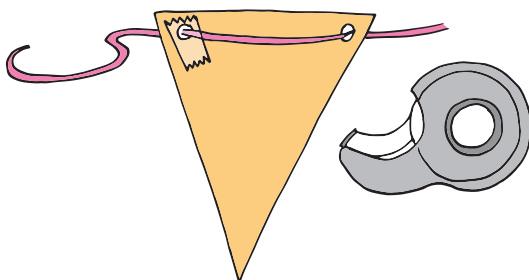
- ③ Lace each shape with string to spell HAPPY
(leave extra string on each end)



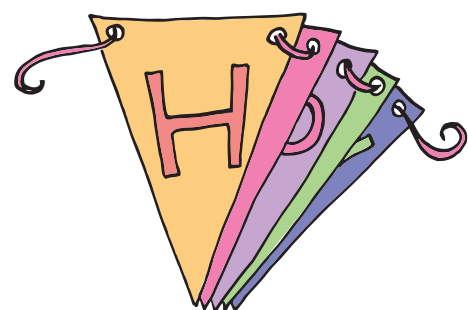
- ④ Lace each shape with string to spell BIRTHDAY
(leave extra string on each end)



- ⑤ Secure first and last letter of each banner
with scotch tape (BACK of banner)
*stops letters from sliding



- ⑥ Fold banner



Confetti Foundation Volunteer Project Banner Instructions

Thank you for choosing the Confetti Foundation for your volunteer project! All the work you complete will be sure to bring smiles and memories to a deserving child and family!

Printing the Banner:

Once each file has been downloaded open the file and select print and print the desired number of banners. **Banners must be printed on 110lb white card stock, single sided in color ink.** *Note each banner is approximately 8 -10 pages in length.

Creating the Banner:

Carefully cut out each pennant letter to spell HAPPY BIRTHDAY. Some themes will include extra pictures, 1-4 based on theme. You can add these pictures to the banners at the beginning of happy, end of happy, beginning of birthday or end of birthday, whichever you prefer.

Once each letter and picture has been cut out on the line carefully, punch out two holes on the top of each pennant letter, approximately 1 inch from top about 4 inches away from each other.


You will then string HAPPY and BIRTHDAY on **two separate strands of baker's twine**, creating **two separate pieces**. One HAPPY strand and one BIRTHDAY strand.

String the banners by selecting one strand of twine. Starting with a themed picture or H, weave the string from the **FRONT** of the pennant to the **BACK**, then move onto the second hole and weave from **BACK** to **FRONT**. Repeat this process through the rest of the pennants. Please leave at least 6 inches of extra baker's twine on each end of HAPPY and BIRTHDAY.

To finish, Turn over the banner, secure the first and last letter, or picture, by placing a small piece of tape on the **BACK** of the pennant over the string to ensure it will not fall off the twine.

Please double check that HAPPY BIRTHDAY is spelled correctly. Fold each banner that is strung with twine, accordion style, so each letter is stacked on top of the next one.





Completion of Project

Once each banner has been created, triple checked for the correct spelling of HAPPY BIRTHDAY and folded accordion style, they can be packaged up and shipped to The Confetti Foundation. All packages are to be sent to the following address:
