Overview

Mini Cat Town's High School Volunteer Program is aimed at students (grades 9-12) who are interested in the opportunity to learn more about kittens, their care, and gaining real world experiences in customer service and animal rescue.



Qualifications

Students should be self starting, motivated to learn, punctual, and team oriented. Interested students must apply online at MiniCatTown.org. Upon initial approval, you must submit a copy of your transcripts (minimum 2.5 GPA), a signed faculty endorsement, and a personal statement.

Commitment

This volunteer opportunity spans all year round. Students will be expected to commit to at least one shift (2-3 hours) every other week. Any more than 3 unexcused absences or tardies are grounds for termination. Transportation is not provided by Mini Cat Town.

Details

Volunteer responsibilities include, but are not limited to, working at the front desk taking payments/waivers, on the adoption floor interacting with both guests and kittens, cleaning the adoption floor and back kitten area, scooping litter boxes, unpacking kitten supply deliveries, feeding kittens, and socializing kittens. All training will be provided.

Mini Cat Town is a 501c(3) non-profit rescue organization. All volunteer hours can be logged and signed off for high school credit. Mini Cat Town is also a proud partner with Americorps in providing the President's Volunteer Service Award to all qualified applicants.
