# Volunteer Role Descriptions

# Silver Rink Guard (2): (15yrs & older)

# Monday - Thursday 12p - 5:15p

Rink Guards, the skaters in neon vests, are on the ice to make sure guests have a safe and enjoyable experience. These volunteers are skilled skaters and are on the ice to enforce the rules and guidelines of the ice. Rink guards will also help guests learn to skate or provide tips. Volunteers must be comfortable and work well with children and beginning skaters. *This is an outdoor position that requires volunteers to have previous ice skating experience.* 

#### Skate Return Assistant (2): (13yrs & older)

## Monday - Thursday 12p - 9:15p | Friday - Sunday: 12p - 11:15p

Volunteers will assist the skate staff to spray, wipe, buckle, and pair skates when placed on the skate return rack. *This will be an indoor/outdoor job that requires volunteers to be on their feet for long periods of time.* 

# Skate Sharpener (1): (18yrs & older)

#### Weekdays 8:30a - 11:30a

Weekday mornings a volunteer will place the skates on a small machine that automatically sharpens the blades of the skates. *This will be an indoor job that requires volunteers to be on their feet for long periods of time (reasonable accommodation can be provided).* \*Some training required\*

# Plaza Pickup: (All Ages)

## Monday - Wednesday: Anytime between 11:30a - 5p

Volunteers will assist the Ice Skating Rink & Ribbon staff with various tasks. Tasks can include picking up around Indian Creek Plaza/Indian Creek/downtown area, washing the windows around the ice rink, ect.
