• Translate program flyers, in writing, on an as-needed basis. If we need translation services in the language(s) in which you have indicated fluency, we will reach out and you can let us know if you are available.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Both professional translators and individuals fluent in English and another language are welcome to apply. High-needs languages include, but Arabic, Farsi, Tigrinya, Oromo, Amharic, Russian, Ukrainian, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
- Must have computer access.

BENEFITS

- Support access to services for immigrants and refugees.
- Gain translation experience.

TIMEFRAME

- As-needed
- This opportunity does not require ongoing commitment.
- Translation must be completed within two weeks of receipt.
