ABOUT THIS PROGRAM

Arizona Youth Partnership's Starting Out Right for Homeless Parenting Youth Program matches pregnant and parenting youth (ages 16-21) who are at risk of becoming homeless with a caring host home within their community. Host homes provide safe housing and support to young families as they work toward becoming stable and self-sufficient with training and support from our case managers.

HOST HOME ELIGIBILITY

- 25 years or older
- Has homeowners or renter's insurance
- Has a spare bedroom
- Owns or leases a home
- Passes background and reference checks
- Ability to secure an Arizona fingerprint clearance card
- Lives in Gila, Maricopa, Mohave, Navajo, Pima or Yavapai Counties
