Listed below are some of our Volunteer Opportunities:

Direct Services

Companionship: visiting with a patient in their home or facility, playing a musical instrument or singing, reading to the patient, listening to music or helping with a craft or activity

Personal assistance:

Haircuts, light housekeeping, doing the laundry, errands, walking the dog, relieving the caregiver for an hour or two

Indirect Services

Clerical work: Making photo copies, answering phone calls, filing, assisting with orientation for new volunteers

Special Interest: Working on special projects, planning holiday and other events, assisting with fundraising events

Bereavement

Praying for or with the patient and family, providing grief support phone calls or visits, attending funerals with the hospice team

If you are interested in becoming part of our hospice volunteer program, we ask that you complete an application with two forms of ID (driver's license, passport, school ID or social security card), provide current auto insurance and attend orientation. We will conduct a pre-screening interview, check personal references and conduct a free background check. You will be required to provide a photo or have your picture taken for your name badge. After all of the paperwork is received and completed, you will receive your patient assignment information and get started!
