- Utilize the Collection Care guidelines for handling, moving, cleaning items in the Museum for all new and changing displays.
- Develop display design with photos, sketches, lists of items in Museum and storyline using PastPerfect Collection Software and other programs as needed.
- Research for information about items in the Museum and create a storyline for displays.
- Enhance existing displays with new items or changes to improve the display.
