UniCycle is a school clothing recycling program that collects and distributes “outgrown, not worn out” items to MNPS students. Together, we’re giving outgrown school clothing a second life, removing barriers to education, and creating community in our schools. You can host a drive as an individual, with a group, or turn your school or business into a UniCycle partner!

We collect what kids wear to school – jeans, joggers, t-shirts and hoodies at non-uniform schools or polo-style collared shirts and khaki, black and navy pants, shorts, skirts and jumpers for uniform schools!

Let’s talk and decide what you want to collect – narrow or broadly focused – and who you want to ask. Then, we’ll decide upon a timeline and other logistics. You can even supplement with an online wish list of our highest priority items.
