

Flannel Washing Instructions

Why so many steps to wash and fold fabric?

Washed flannel, smoothly rolled and unwrinkled back on to the cardboard form, not only saves us a lime cutting out the pajama pieces, it makes our pattern pieces more accurate.

- 1. Unwind flannel off the cardboard form and unfold. Please save the cardboard form you'll need this!
- 2. Depending on the size of your washer, wash up to two bolts maximum of flannel in warm water.
- 3. Dry one bolt of flannel at a time. This saves a lot of time in the long run, since two bolts in one dryer get very twisted and tangled.
- 4. Dry flannel completely so it is ready to cut once we receive it.
- 5. Fold flannel in half lengthwise matching selvedge edges (the selvedge edge is usually white and has manufacturer information). It is helpful to work as a team to align the selvedge edges and smooth the flannel.
- 6. Roll the flannel back on the cardboard form like it was before it was washed.
 *HOT TIP: A quick way to fold the flannel back on the cardboard form is to drape the flannel over the side of a bed creating tension and "drag" in the flannel as you align, smooth and roll the flannel back on the cardboard.
- 7. Return your washed flannel in plastic bags either to the church office between 9:00am and 2:00pm at 925 Balour Drive, Encinitas or to the Family Center the morning of our next workday.
