Saturday June 24, 2023 Volunteer Positions

This fun, outdoor event is a wonderful way to see the incredible Christopher Farm & Gardens while supporting a great cause. Please note that all volunteers may be subject to a background check. You will receive a t-shirt to wear for your shift.

Activities/Games – This person will engage guests in a game, or activity (giant jenga, lawn games, etc).

First Aid—Should be First Aid/CPR certified, comfortable handling small emergencies, and able to call 9-1-1 should a large emergency arise.

Floater–This person is willing to jump in wherever help is needed and/or to give other volunteers a break. Will also help direct/answer quest questions about the grounds.

Food/Beverage Server–Serve food and beverages to guests; excellent customer service and communication skills. This position may require long periods of standing and reaching.

Fork Auction–Monitor the fork auction items and encourage bidding by guests. Those in the final shift will help gather bid sheets, and transport forks to the main tent.

Greeter/Guide-Have you been to the farm before? If you are able to help greet guests and share with them "which way to go" to get to events/activities/gardens please let us know! The friendlier the better.

Parking– Need someone organized who likes neat rows! Direct traffic in the parking area to ensure that cars are positioned neatly and direct guests to the registration tent. This position requires standing, repetitive arm movements and good customer service skills. This position starts at 2 p.m.

Raffle Ticket Sales—Walk the grounds selling raffle tickets and other items. An outgoing personality required.

Silent Auction–Monitor the silent auction items and encourage bidding by guests. Those in the final shift may help gather bid sheets and disperse winnings.

Set–Up (Friday 6/23 and/or Saturday 6/24) – Assist Meals On Wheels and the grounds crew with setting up tables, chairs, banners, pop-up tents, signage, etc. in preparation for the event. **Note: the tables are heavy.**

Tear-Down (Sunday 6/25) – Assist with tearing down tables, chairs tents, pop-up tents, decorations, signs, etc., and ensure the grounds look the same if not better than before the event took place. **Note: the tables are heavy.**
