

# How to verify vaccine status

Effective Oct 18, 2021, King County issued an Executive Order that requires all King County contractors and volunteers working on site to be fully vaccinated when performing work in person.


## Accepted verification\*

- Photo of CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card
- Documentation of vaccination from a health care provider, electronic health record, or state immunization information system record

*\*For an individual vaccinated outside of the United States, a reasonable equivalent of any of the above.*

## How it works

- ✓ Vaccination status checked each time you volunteer.
- ✓ Vaccination status verified at sign-in.
- ✓ No data or images of your vaccination status retained.
