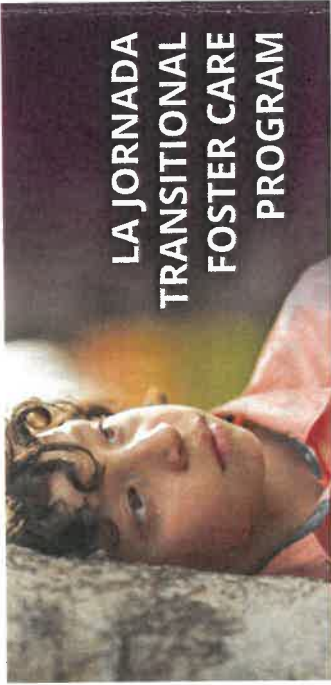




LA JORNADA TRANSITIONAL FOSTER CARE PROGRAM

They're **unaccompanied children and youth**. Here in the U.S. without adult supervision, many under the age of 13.

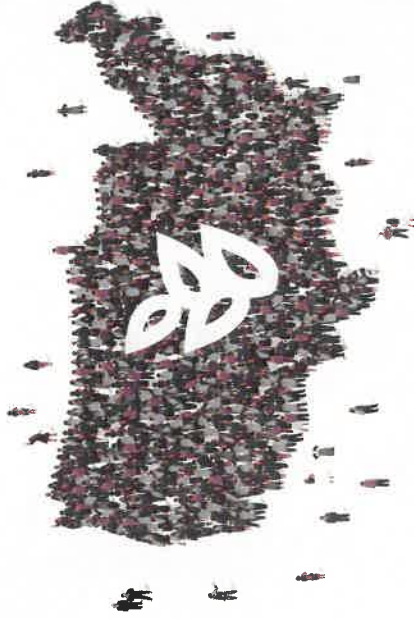
They need a home where they can receive the care and attention that **every child and youth deserves.**

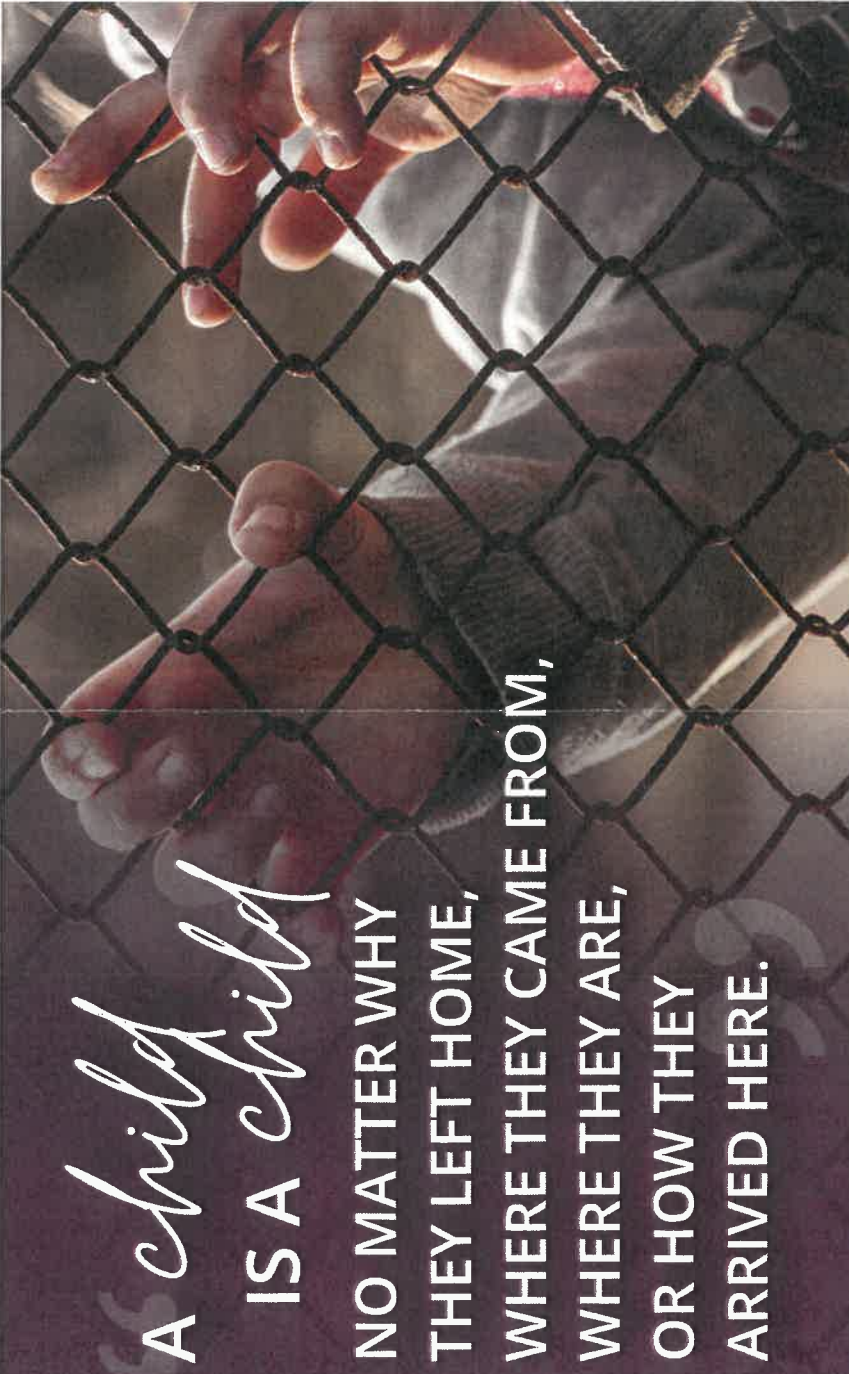

- ✎ **Open your heart and home** by becoming a licensed NYAP foster parent today.
- ✎ **Spread the word about the pressing need for foster parents** among your circle of friends, family, local congregation, clubs, or teams. Encourage those who might be willing to provide a safe and nurturing home to reach out to us. Your advocacy can make a significant difference in a child or youth's life.

- ✎ **Post on social media** about the need for bilingual, Spanish-speaking foster homes.

QUALIFICATIONS

- ✎ Be 21 years of age or older
- ✎ One can be single, married or divorced
- ✎ Have adequate space in your home for a child or youth
- ✎ Have sufficient income to manage one's own expenses
- ✎ Own or rent adequate housing
- ✎ Be in good physical and mental health
- ✎ Ability to work as a team with NYAP's educators, therapists and case managers
- ✎ Ability to keep children and youth safe in your home ensuring their daily needs are met
