Why CERT?

- To protect yourself first so that you will be able to help others.
- To prepare your family and home to survive all types of disasters.
- To assist family and neighbors during the time of a disaster.
- To work as part of an emergency response team at work or in the community.

Get Ready — Get Trained

The Community Emergency Response Team Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area. Individuals are trained in basic disaster response skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises. CERT Team members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event if or when professional responders are not immediately available to help.

- FEMA certified Basic CERT Training Course is about 24-hours of training scheduled over a number of weeks.
- Minimum age requirement is 16 years.
- Pre-registration is required.
- Participants receive a disaster preparedness manual, an emergency supply kit and a Certificate of Completion.
