Title School – based Mentor Department Public Schools Outreach Program(s) School – based mentoring

Objective To build and cultivate a relationship with an assigned group of youngster through a variety of activities that promote academic achievement, character development and advocate against school dropout.

Duties/Responsibilities a. **Set Goals**: the mentor will work with the students to develop long range goals for the students' academic and personal life.

b. **Be a Role Model**: the mentor will be a role model to the student, demonstrating attitudes and qualities of effective mentoring such as punctuality, dependability and trust.

c. **Plan and Participate in Activities**: the mentor will plan and implement activities that create a sense of belonging and participate in the annual back-to-school rallies, if available.

d. **Be a Friend**: the mentor will have realistic goals and expectations; have fun together; give youth a voice and choice in deciding on activities; be positive; allow students to select discussion topics; listen; respect the trust the youth places in you; remember your relationships is with the youth and not the youth's parent; and remember you are responsible for building the relationship.

e. **Assist with Academic Assignments**: it is possible for the mentor to check homework, assist with test preparation, make suggestions about research and tutor the student, only if there is additional time allotted within the session.

f: **Encourage Students to Set Goals and Stay in School**: The mentor will help students appreciate the importance of education, both personally and professionally.

g. **Cooperate with Staff**: The mentor will share with the 360 staff areas of concern with volunteers, program(s) and participants; assist with record keeping and the documentation of program activities; and help monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of program(s); and performs all other duties assigned by the school Mentor Coordinator.
