



Mesa Fire and Medical Department Needs Volunteers

The Home Safety Education Program is a free Mesa Fire and Medical Department program available to all City of Mesa residents. The program aims to reduce the risks of falls and fires inside the home and to link citizens to outside resources if needed.

Safety volunteers work in teams of two. One person is the educator, who provides safety information and fall prevention strategies to the resident. The other volunteer installs grab bars and smoke alarms (some basic experience in tool usage is needed).



Requirements

- 18 years of age at time of hire
- Valid AZ Driver License with good driving record.
- Ability to pass a background process.
- Ability to volunteer 4 hours each week (Monday-Thursday).

All training, tools, uniforms, vehicle, and application costs are provided by the Mesa Fire and Medical Department.
